Corbin Mills started the day two strokes off the lead after he finished day one with a 68. The Easley, SC native came home with a 67 to win by two over Robert Register. A back nine of 32 gave him the cushion he needed for his first major national win. “Solid play and a good short game got me around on a tough day” said the future Clemson Tiger.

Normally played at the Country Club of Spartanburg, The Carolina Country Club is host for the 2008 event due to renovations at the home course for the tournament. Carolina Country Club is host to the BMW Charity Pro-Am for the Nationwide Tour and has been a wonderful host for the one year hiatus.

The 2008 field represents Canada, Slovenia, and 13 states were invited based on their 2008 accomplishments. The 84 players have combined for 7 AJGA victories, 13 state junior championships, qualified for 13 USGA events, 20 other major wins, and has an average handicap of well below scratch.

The tournament is held in honor of the late Robert H. Chapman, Jr. Chapman, a long time member of the Country Club of Spartanburg, was the only man to serve as president of both the South Carolina Golf Association & Carolinas Golf Association. He was an accomplished player and served the USGA in several capacities. In his business life, Chapman was a local and national leader in the textile industry. The tournament also benefits the Spartanburg Foundation and the South Carolina Junior Golf Foundation. To date, over \$100,000 has gone to scholarship recipients through both organizations thanks to the many kind supporters of the Bobby Chapman.
