Joseph Winslow started the day with a two stroke lead and opened with a one over par front nine. “I gave myself a little pep talk on the turn and was able to turn around the day” said the Kansas native. Birdies on 11 and 12 got him back in the lead and a lone bogey on the 18th still gave the young man a great championship. South Carolina’s Cody Proveaux got off to a hot start as he was 4 under through his first six holes. As the leaders came back to the field, Proveaux put himself right in the middle of the tournament. Bogies on 9 and 10 slowed the charge and he finished with a birdie on the last to finish in solo second, one shot back of Winslow.

The 2010 field represents 17 states with 7 respective State Champions making their way to Spartanburg. The field participated in 24 USGA Championships, won 10 AJGA titles along with 29 other major championships. The Alumni list is also quite impressive as former US Open Champion ; Lucas Glover, is our first champion. The USGA Amateur runner up, David Chung is also a past participant as well as the player that defeated Chung in the finals. Peter Uilhien captured two Chapman titles on his way to Oklahoma State and his Amateur Championship earned the youngster a spot in the 2011 Masters.

The tournament is held in honor of the late Robert H. Chapman, Jr. Chapman, a long time member of the Country Club of Spartanburg, was the only man to serve as president of both the South Carolina Golf Association & Carolinas Golf Association. He was an accomplished player and served the USGA in several capacities. In his business life, Chapman was a local and national leader in the textile industry. The tournament also benefits the Spartanburg County Foundation and the South Carolina Junior Golf

Foundation. To date, over \$110,000 has gone to scholarship recipients through both organizations thanks to the many kind supporters of the Bobby Chapman.
