SJCGA Point System

The point system is the vehicle for recognizing a player's achievement and participation. Players accumulate tournament points based upon their finish. The players best four finishes will determine qualification to play in the Chapter 2-day Tour Championship where the top 2 players go to All-Stars.

1st - 25 points 2nd - 20 points
3rd - 16 points 4th - 10 points
top 10 - 5points top 20 - 3 points

All Stars – 18 year olds must not yet be in college, nor turn 19 before All Stars at Sea Brook Island in August.

The SCJGA was built on a foundation of networking community junior golf programs referred to as "Chapters." Chapters give juniors an opportunity to be a part of a local, fun, summer golf tournament schedule designed to develop tournament skills, teach a working knowledge of the Rules of Golf, and build lasting friendships. The Pee Dee Chapter of the SCJGA is one of 19 local programs around the state.

SCJGA Official State Points

In the Boys 15-18 and Girls 14-18 age groups the top 3 guaranteed or the top 25% of the age division with the most points out of **all** of the events (**not top 4**) at the end of the regular Pee Dee Chapter season will receive the SCJGA official state rankings points at a multiplier 2. So the player with the most points will receive $25 \times 2 = 50$ SCJGA state points. 2nd place will get $20 \times 2 = 40$ and 3rd place will get $16 \times 2 = 32$ etc. All-Stars will also be a multiplier 2 with more places for state points.

Conduct / Etiquette

Proper golfing attire (collared shirt, dress slacks or shorts, hat if worn bill facing front) is mandatory and the use of the facilities **will be denied to anyone** not attired properly. **NO BLUE JEAN** material. Spectators too are expected to show the same respect for the honorable game of golf and to their golfers with proper attire.

All Pee Dee junior golfers are required to become members of the "Good Golfer Club"... meaning those who leave the golf course in better shape than they found it!

No horse play is allowed on the golf course. Any damage to the golf course must be reported as soon as possible.
