# RULES AND POLICIES

- USGA Rules of golf will apply except where local rules apply. Players caught cheating will be penalized within the rules of golf & will be suspended for the next event.
- Proper attire is required at all tournaments and other activities. Golf shirts must be worn. No cut-offs, jeans, swimming attire or tank tops allowed. A player may be asked to leave the course for inappropriate attire. Caps should be worn with the bill in the forward position.

## Offenses will be penalized as follows:

**First Offense** - two stroke penalty or disqualification if deemed necessary

**Second Offense** - suspension of membership

- No swearing or abusive language.
  - No alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs or gambling.
  - No throwing clubs.
  - Rake bunkers.
  - Throw trash in proper receptacles, not on ground.
  - Players must walk and carry their own bag or use a pull cart.
  - You must keep up with the group ahead of you.
  - Spectators can not give advise to players. Penalty - **disqualification**
  - Spectator carts are not permitted — only BJGA officials and scorers may use carts. Spectators must remain on the cart path.
  - Players in the group must exchange score cards on the 1st tee (Except for ages 8 to 12, which will have a scorer with each group).
  - Following play, each score card is to be checked, signed and attested by each player before turning it in at the scorer's table. Incorrect score cards will be treated by Rule #38 in the USGA Rules of Golf.
  - Unexcused no-shows or "no-cards" will not be eligible to participate at the next scheduled tournament.
  - The decisions of the tournament director or host professional will be final.
- Late players or players that did not pre-register will only be able to participate if a slot in the tee times become available.

## MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION:

The BJGA enables youth (ages 8-17) to learn the game of golf and to participate in age appropriate tournaments.

## QUALIFICATIONS:

Entrants must have demonstrated a basic understanding of the game of golf.

## ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all boys and girls ages 8 to 17. Must be 8 years old prior to June 1. Age as of June 1, 2011 determines age for the entire BJGA tournament schedule.

## TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

Stroke play competition USGA Rules of Golf with the following age groups established by the SCJGA:

### BOYS

Ages 8-9 Yrs. Old / Special Forward Tees / 5-Holes  
Ages 10-12 Yrs. Old / Ladies or Sr Tees / 9-Holes  
Ages 13-14 Yrs. Old / Regular Tees / 18-Holes  
Ages 15-17 Yrs. Old / Regular Tees / 18-Holes

### GIRLS

Ages 8-10 Yrs. Old / Special Forward Tees / 5-Holes  
Ages 11-13 Yrs. Old / Ladies Tees / 9-Holes  
Ages 14-17 Yrs. Old / Ladies Tees / 18-Holes

Players who can not play must contact the association staff before 2:00 pm on the Sunday prior to each event or the player will be suspended for the following week.

## MEMBERSHIP FEE / REGISTRATION:

Membership fee is \$100, payable on registration day at Gifford's Golf, June 20th, 9:00 am. Fee includes entry fees for all tournaments, clinics and activities. Please bring your completed registration form and membership fee to Gifford's Golf on June 20 or mail to the BJGA at 30 Grober Hill Rd, Beaufort, SC 29906.

\*\*\*\*\*Membership entitles each participant to compete in six 1-day events and qualify for the Tournament of Champions at season's end. Each will receive drinks & snacks at the events. Points are rewarded for each age group for each tournament.

## QUALIFICATION SYSTEM - TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS

Players must compete in a minimum of four events to be eligible. One of the four events can be waived if player participates in a SCJGA event that is scheduled at the same time such as "The Blade" or The SC Junior Championship. The top 8 finishers from each age group, based on the points system, will qualify to compete in the Tournament of Champions finale at The Secession Club to be held on Tuesday, Aug 9. The top 8 qualifiers will be determined immediate following play in each age division at the final regular season event on Monday, Aug 1.

\*\*\*\*\*Tournament prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in each age group at each tournament site. \*\*\*\*\*Participants must pre-register by Wednesday at 5:00 pm prior to a tournament

The top 2 in each BOYS DIVISION & the top finisher in each GIRLS DIVISION will qualify for the ALL-STAR CHAMPIONSHIP which will be held at Seabrook Country Club in Seabrook Island, SC on August 13 & 14, 20110
