

# Rules and Policies

## Qualifications System for Tournament of Champions

Players must compete in a minimum of 4 events to be eligible. One of the four can be waived if participation in a SCJGA event is at the same time. Example, "The Blade." The top 8 finishers per age group, based on the point system, will qualify to compete in the Tournament of Champions finale at Greenwood Country Club on Monday, August 2 and Tuesday, August 3. Qualifiers will be determined after tournament #6.

### Tees and Number of Holes Played

#### Boys:

Ages 8-9: Special Forward Tees /5 holes  
Ages 10-12: Ladies or Senior Tees /9 holes  
Ages 13-14: Regular Tees /9 holes  
Ages 15-17: Regular Tees /9 holes

#### Girls:

Ages 8-10: Special Forward Tees /5 holes  
Ages 11-13: Ladies Tees /9 holes  
Ages 14-17: Ladies Tees /9 holes

\*Tournament prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in each age group at each tournament sight.

- USGA Rules will apply except when local rules take effect.
- Proper attire is required at all tournaments and other activities. Collared shirts must be worn and tucked into pants. No cut-offs, jeans, swimming attire, tank tops or short shorts allowed. A player may be asked to leave a course for inappropriate attire. Caps should be worn with the bill in the forward position.
- No swearing or abusive language. No alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs, or gambling. No throwing clubs or cheating. Replace divots, repair ball marks, rake bunkers, and do not throw your trash on the ground. Violation penalty: a) TWO SHOT PENALTY, b) DISQUALIFICATION, c) SUSPENSION AS DEEMED BY TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE.
- Players must walk and carry their own bags or use a pull cart
- You must keep up with the group ahead of you.  
Spectators cannot give advice to players.  
Penalty: Disqualification
- Spectator carts are not permitted— only PJGA officials and scorers. Spectators must remain on the cart path.
- Players in the group must exchange cards on the 1st tee (except for ages 8 to 12—they will have a scorer). Scorecards are to be checked, signed, and attested, before turning in at the scorer's table. Incorrect score cards will be treated by rule #38-USGA.
- Unexcused no-shows or no-scorecards will not be eligible to participate at the next scheduled tournament.
- The decisions of the tournament director or host professional will be final.
- Late players will only be able to participate if another slot is available.

## Membership Information

The PJGA enables youth (ages 8-17) to learn the game of golf and to participate in age appropriate tournaments.

### Eligibility:

Open to all boys and girls ages 8 to 17. Must be 8 years old by June 1 and cannot be 18 years old prior to June 1. Age as of June 1, 2010 determines age for the entire PJGA tournament schedule.

### Qualifications:

Entrants must have demonstrated a basic understanding of the game.

Entrants must reside in the 4- county area of the Piedmont Chapter, which are Greenwood, Abbeville, Laurens and McCormick.

### Membership Fee/Registration:

Membership fee is \$75, payable on registration day at Greenwood Country Club, May 17, between 5:30 p.m.- 6:30 p.m. Fee includes entry fees for all tournaments, clinics and activities. Please bring your completed registration form and membership fee to Greenwood Country Club on May 17 or mail to the PJGA, P.O. Box 919, Greenwood, SC 29649. (Note: Families with two or more registrants will receive \$10 off of each fee.)

\*\*\*Membership entitles each participant to compete in six 1-day events and qualify for the Tournament of Champions at season's end. Each will receive drinks and snacks at the events. Points are rewarded for each age group for each tournament.

### Tournament Entries / Starting Times

The deadline for entry into any tournament will be the Wednesday prior to that particular tournament. Players may also register at the previous tournament for the next week. **PARTICIPANTS WHO HAVE NOT PREREGISTERED FOR THE WEEK'S EVENT ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZES OR TOURNAMENT CREDIT.** All starting times will be announced in the Index-Journal on the Sunday prior to each tournament, or you may call the Pro Shop at GCC (942-8862). Players who cannot play must contact the GCC Pro Shop before 2:00 p.m. on the Sunday prior to each event or the player will be suspended for the following week.
