Pickens –

Tyler Lucas continued his hot play with seven birdies on the day to end at 68 for his overall championship in the Thomas D Todd All Stars Championship. He won by four, but the bracket was tough with the top six competitors ending up under par for the championship. Lucas broke the tournament record set by Bradley Tedstone last year by four shots. Kelli Murphy continued her hot summer of play with the overall girls title after she finished the day at 67 and won by a convincing eight shots while also setting a new tourney record. Zachary Bishop started the day at four over par for the event. Six birdies ended up with 69 on the board and the Boy 13-14 title.

The Boys 10-12 bracket needed extra holes as Brady Hinkle (Lancaster) and Ryan Marter (Columbia) tied at two under 70. Marter birdied the tough par 5 18th to take the championship.

Victoria Huskey tied the low round of the day with a 40 in the Girls 11-13 bracket to win her division handily with a two day total of 77. The Greenville native won by five shots and her solid play all weekend gave her the cushion to be able to play conservatively on the final nine. Jensen Castle was able to hold off her sister to claim the Girls 8-10 bracket with a two day total of 75 and a five shot margin of victory.

The Todd family presents the championship in Thomas D Todd's name in honor to his contributions to the game and their family. The Todd family has long been a part of the SC amateur golf picture with numerous SCGA titles in their history. Pickens Country Club is again host to the junior tournament and many other programs of the SCJGA. They are part of the AAG Golf Group (www.aaggolfgroup.com) and are tremendous supporters of junior golf in the upstate.

The juniors are age 8-18 and broken into seven age brackets for the two day competition. The younger brackets competed over nine holes of play while the boy's 13-14, 15-18, and girl's 14-18 all played 18 holes of individual stroke play. Each chapter brought two players from each age bracket that earned their way into the championship via their summer play. Over the two days, the best scores of the boys and girls will be totaled for a chapter championship as well. Greenville won the boys championship for the fourth year in a row while Anderson took the overall girls title.

Format: USGA rules apply, 18-hole stroke play.

Eligibility: Open to junior members of the SCJGA age 8-18, still enrolled in high school.
