*2026 Local Rules & Reminders*



SCJGA Hard Card

**Starting play:** Be sure to arrive at your starting hole 10 minutes before your tee time. There is NO registration table.

**Format:** 12 & Under divisions will play 9 holes of individual stroke play. 13-19 divisions will play 18 holes of individual stroke play.

**Maximum Score:** The maximum score on any hole is double par. Once a player reaches double par, they should pick up their ball and record that score.

**Walking only:** All players must walk and transport their own clubs. Push carts are permitted. Players may ride in a golf cart only to the next teeing area after holing out on the hole prior.

**Caddies:** Caddies MUST be 25 years old or younger. Parents and spectators may not transport clubs or give advice and must always remain on cart paths, other than helping in search of a ball.

**Distance measuring devices:** Allowed, provided they measure distance only. NO slope.

**Pace of Play:** Pace of play is VERY important. Please play ready golf and always keep up with the group in front of you. Excessively slow play will result in penalties and/or disqualification. We expect 2 hours & 15 minutes for 9 holes, 4 hours & 30 minutes for 18 holes.

**Provisional Balls:** If there is a chance that your ball is lost or out of bounds, please play a provisional ball to help pace of play.

**Drop Zones:** All local drop zones are in effect and may be used as an additional relief option.

**Rules Uncertainty:** In the event a competitor has a question about the rules, he/she can play a second ball (Rule 20.1c(2)) and upon completion of the round, IMMEDIATELY report the facts to the committee and a decision will be made.

**Scoring:** Please report to the scoring table following your round. All scorecards must be marked and attested. If a tie occurs, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff for first place only.

**BE SAFE & HAVE FUN:** Golf is fun, but getting hit with a golf club or golf ball is not. Always be aware of your surroundings.

**ETIQUETTE:** We are guests, please take care of the course! Remember to rake all bunkers, repair divots & ball marks, and NO bags or push carts on the putting green!

**ATTIRE:** Appropriate golf course attire is required for all players and spectators.
